

PUBLIC NOTICE OF PRIMARY ELECTION
FOR JACKSON COUNTY ON JUNE 8, 2010

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all eligible and qualified electors of Jackson County, State of Iowa, that a Primary Election shall be held for said County on June 8, 2010. Said election shall be conducted according to Chapters 43, 47, 48, 49, 50, 52, 53 and 56 of 2009 Code of Iowa.

FURTHER PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the following sixteen (16) precincts and polling locations shall be used for said election in addition to the designated absentee polling place.

ALL POLLING PLACES in Jackson County are accessible to the disabled person. Any voter who is physically unable to enter a polling place has the right to vote in the voter's vehicle. Other necessary accommodations shall be available upon request as required by Federal and State laws.

VOTING MACHINE TESTING shall begin on Wednesday, May 26th at 1:00 p.m. and will continue until all machines are tested. The county chairperson of each political party shall be notified in writing of the time said machines shall be examined and tested so that they may be present or have a representative present.

POLLING PLACE HOURS for the regular sixteen precincts during said election shall be from seven o'clock (7:00) a.m. until nine o'clock (9:00) p.m. An AccuVote Optical Scan, precinct count voting machines will be used for said election on June 8, 2010. An AutoMark Voter Assisted Terminal, a ballot marking device, shall be available to assist disable voters.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS MAY BE CAST by registered voters through Monday, June 7, 2010 in the Auditor's Office at the Courthouse located at 201 West Platt Street, Maquoketa, Iowa, during regular weekdays from 8:30 a.m. through 4:30 p.m. The Auditor's Office shall also be open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 29, 2010, which is the deadline for voter pre-registration. The office shall be open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Saturday, June 5, 2010, for absentee voting. As an alternative method, upon a submission of a State of Iowa's Official Absentee Request Form, with a written signature, an absentee ballot will be sent by U.S. Mail to the qualified voter. A VOTER MUST SPECIFY A REPUBLICAN PARTY BALLOT OR A DEMOCRATIC PARTY BALLOT WHEN THEY MAKE THEIR OFFICIAL REQUEST FOR A BALLOT. Deadline for absentee and ballots returned by mail must have a postmark of Monday, June 7, 2010.

A bipartisan team will also deliver ballots to a person requesting a ballot in the Jackson County Regional Health Center or a state approved nursing facility. All unused or unmarked ballots must be returned.

ELECTION DAY REGISTRATION at the polling place for the precinct you currently live in will require proof of residence with a current address in the precinct and identity with a photo ID and if you register after May 29, 2010 pre-registration deadline. You may vote in the auditor's office after the voter pre-registration deadline and you will follow the election day registration procedure. You will fill out a voter registration form, show your proof of residence and identity, sign an oath and be given an absentee ballot to vote. The best form of ID is a valid Iowa driver's license with current address. Contact the Auditor's Office if more information is needed regarding Election Day Registration.

On Election Day, registered electors who have moved to a different precinct shall vote at the precinct in which they currently reside. Electors shall be required to fill out a change of address form prior to being allowed to cast their ballot.

VOTING FOR FEDERAL, STATE, AND COUNTY CANDIDATES shall be by use of AccuVote Optical Scan voting machines and the ballot to cast votes shall be substantially in the same form as set out on the sample ballot of first rotation published along with this notice of election. Where more than one candidate is listed for the same office, the candidate's names shall be rotated from precinct to precinct.

VOTERS MUST DECLARE A POLITICAL PARTY OF REPUBLICAN OR DEMOCRATIC when voting at the polling place. Voters may change from their current political party to another when they sign their voter declaration. The voter's official registration record will be changed to reflect the political affiliation used at the poll. Any political changes made after the election are not effective until the Primary Election records have been updated by the Auditor's Office.

QUALIFIED ELECTORS ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED TO APPEAR AT THE POLLING PRECINCT IN WHICH THEY CURRENTLY RESIDE to cast their ballot for the June 8, 2010 Primary Election, during the aforesaid hours and at the aforesaid precinct and polling locations.
