The Jackson County Jail Advisory Committee would like to welcome you to an open house at the Jackson County Sheriff's Office/Jail. The open house will take place on June 27, 2018 starting at 2PM. The open house tours will run every hour on the hour starting at 2PM with the last tour taking place during the 7PM hour. There will be a total of 6 one hour tours. The hour long tours will consist of a walk-through our current facility, identifying the deficiencies, and will conclude with a short question and answer at the end of the hour. All inmates will be housed in a different county during the tour which will allow access to the entire facility.

This is one of the ways to inform the public as to the daily safety issues our employees face and the lack of operating space that we currently have in our outdated and unsecure facility. Voting takes place from 7AM-8PM and we would like to remind everyone to get out and vote for this very important bond referendum.
